Application Procedures

April 1st, 2017 is the application deadline for the academic year 2017-18. Incomplete applications and those received after April 1st may not be considered.

- 1. Fill out and sign the <u>International Guest Student Application</u>. (Section B pages 5-6)
- 2. Submit <u>one letter of recommendation</u> from your home university or from your sponsor organization recommending you for study at the College of Engineering and Computer Science of the University of Michigan Dearborn.
- 3. Submit an English translation of your official transcript from your home university.
- 4. Submit <u>Verification of English Language Proficiency</u> form (Section C page 7)

*Students applying to a MS or MSE program must provide TOEFL score of at least 84, IELTS score of 6.5, or MELAB score of 80 or above.

5. Fill out and sign the <u>Study Plan form</u> (Section D page 8).

Students will be notified of their admission by the Office of Admissions & Orientation.

This application is only valid for students NOT completing an undergraduate degree prior to September 2016.

A. Affidavit of Financial Resources

- Submit an <u>original bank certification</u> (in English) from your financial supporter, converted to U.S. dollars with minimum amount of \$14,362 per semester (\$28,652 for two semesters) to cover tuition, living expenses, books, supplies, and health insurance.

(Without the scholarship, costs are estimated as \$45,400 per year.)
